Friday Schooling:	\$15	Per horse / rider combo *Main Area Open Schooling Friday noon - 5pm ONLY*
Warm Up:	\$ 7	Per mount / per trip OR get a \$25 "Warm UP Bracelet!!" (covers Friday Schooling, "Warm Up 1" on Friday and "Warm Up 2" on Saturday.)
Early Entry Credit:	\$10	Credit given to total Show Bill if entry is received by the Sunday before the show. Two class minimum required .

Office Fee:	\$20	Per Entry:
Medic:	\$10	Per Rider:
Showing Ship-In Only:	\$25	Showing - Ship-In Only - \$25 per day.
Friday Non-Showing Ship-In:	\$45	Non-Showing Ship-In Friday - (Covers Office, Medic, and Friday Schooling.)
Saturday Non-Showing Ship-In:	\$45	Non-Showing Ship-In Saturday - (Covers Office, Medic, and Ground use.)
Stall - One Day:	\$40	Stall - One day only.
Stall - Week End:	\$70	Stall (weekend) arrive before 3:00pm on Friday.
Tack Stall:	\$40/\$70	Same cost as horse stall, but must be included in entry.
Water & Electric Hook-Up:	\$40	Per day OR \$70 for the weekend.
LATE ENTRY FEE:	\$20	LATE ENTRY FEE will be charged if entry received after the Wednesday before the show.
Scratch Fee:	\$ 3	Per class *MUST * be done at the office prior to fence height adjustment for class.(or pay full price.)
Convenience Fee:	\$ 5	Charged per show bill if paying with PayPal.
Open Balance Fee:	\$25	Per show if unpaid balance is remaining.
Team Rosters:		Team rosters must be submitted to show secretary by 5pm Friday.
Team Roster's Fee:	Pet Food	Please bring dry or canned pet food, to benefit the "Southeast Volusia Humane Society".
Small Barn Division:		5 (or fewer) horse/rider combinations. Lead line riders do not affect the horse/rider numbers.
Large Barn Division:		6 - 15 horse/rider combinations. Lead line riders do not affect the horse/rider numbers.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Entry is not complete and contestant numbers WILL NOT be issued until the signed entry form, signed waiver, payment (including an open check), AND current negative Coggins / Info are RECEIVED.
- A current negative Coggins is required to enter the premises.
- A separate entry form is required for EACH horse and rider combination.
- Office fee is required for each entry. Medic Fee is per rider only.
- There is a \$5.00 convenience fee for use of PayPal for each transaction, whether a payment or a refund. PayPal to: ssbc1948@gmail.com
- Proper tack AND dress are required; including boots and ASTM rated helmet. No dressage whips are permitted. Each rider must wear a number.
Polo Shirts Are Encouraged !
- Entries received by the Sunday, immediately prior to the show, entering in a minimum of two classes, will receive a \$10 pre-entry credit.
- When a class starts and your number is called, you have 3 minutes to enter the arena. If you do not enter, you go to the end of the line, unless you were the last rider, then you forfeit your round and are still responsible for payment.
- No minimum number of riders for any class. Three riders must complete the class for first place prizes to be awarded.
- To qualify for "Championship Award" rider must show in 2 of 3, or 3 of 4 classes.
- For the safety of our competitors, a medic will be present throughout all judged classes.
- Scratches must be submitted to the office prior to the "fence height change" for the class you are riding, otherwise you will be responsible for full payment.
- Judging is based on USHJA and SSBC rules. Judge's and Show Manager's decisions are final.
- There is NO TURNOUT anywhere on SSBC property.
- ALL stallions must be handled by an adult, 18 years or older.
- Anyone riding a horse on SSBC property, must sign a SSBC "Waiver & Indemnity" release form
- AND wear an ASTM rated helmet.
- SSBC is not responsible for loss or injury to a horse, rider, or property.
- Contributions/Gifts to SSBC Inc. are not deductible contributions for Federal Income Tax purposes.
- All dogs MUST be on a leash.

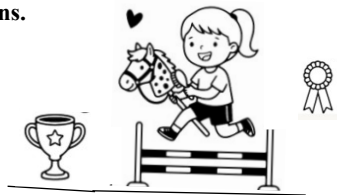
