

# Just Jumpers Schedule and Show Bill

## Classes:

1A-Ground Poles-speed	4A-2'-2'3" -speed
1B- Ground Poles-clear with jump off	4B-2'-2'3"-clear with jump off
1C-Ground Poles-jackpot	4C-2'-2'3"-jackpot
2A-Cross Rails-speed	5A-2'6"-2'9" -speed
2B-Cross Rails-clear with jump off	5B-2'6"-2'9"-clear with jump off
2C-Cross Rails-jackpot	5C-2'6"-2'9"-jackpot
3A-18" -speed	6A-3'-speed
3B-18"-clear with jump off	6B-3'-clear with jump off
3C-18"-jackpot	6C-3'-jackpot
	*up to 3'6" (A, B, C) with advanced request

\*There is no minimum number of riders required for any class, including the jackpot classes!

\***Prizes:** For speed classes (A and B), ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place will be given out. For jackpot classes (C), 75% of the total entry fees collected will be paid out at the rate of 50% for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 30% for 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 20% for 3<sup>rd</sup> place; rounding up or down depending upon the amount of change. **Winnings will be credited towards any open show bill and any remaining moneys will be paid out in cash.**

\*Ground Pole classes will be limited to no more than 6 jumps.



\***TIP Awards** will be given out for two heights: 2'3" and below and 2'6" and above. Be sure to register your eligible off the track thoroughbred at [www.tjctip.com](http://www.tjctip.com) to participate.

1. Entry is **not complete and contestant numbers will NOT issue until the signed entry form, signed waiver, payment (including an open check), and current negative coggins/info are RECEIVED.** A current negative coggins is required to enter premises.
2. A separate entry form is required for each horse and rider combination. **Office fee** is required for each entry. **Medic Fee** is per rider only.
3. There is a \$5.00 convenience fee for the use of PayPal for each transaction, whether a payment or a refund. Paypal to [ssbc1948@gmail.com](mailto:ssbc1948@gmail.com)
4. Proper tack and dress is required, including boots & ATSM rated helmet. No dressage whips are permitted. Each rider must wear a number.
5. Email entries by the Sunday immediately prior to the show, register for and show in a minimum of two A and B classes and receive a \$10 pre-entry credit.
6. Prizes: Riders in A and B classes will receive ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> -6<sup>th</sup> place. Jackpot riders, J classes, will receive CASH prizes for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> place.
7. **NO MINIMUM NUMBER OF RIDERS FOR ANY CLASS, INCLUDING JACKPOT CLASSES.**
8. For JACKPOT classes, you must ride at least 1 other class at the height of the jackpot jumper round you are riding.
9. For JACKPOT classes, you may **ONLY** ride 2 jackpot rounds **PER SHOW** and they must be at two consecutive heights, i.e., if you ride the 18" jackpot round, you can ride the 2'-2'3" round, but no higher jackpot round. You can ride higher A and B classes.
10. Everyone renting a stall must pay the \$10 stall cleaning fee for each stall rented, whether for a horse or a tack stall. SSBC members may not use work certificates to pay that fee.
11. Judge's and show manager's decisions are final.
12. There is **NO SCHOOLING**, mounted or in hand, **IN THE COVERED ARENA** at any time, **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Riders may walk the courses.
13. There is **NO TURN OUT** anywhere on SSBC property, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
14. **All stallions** must be handled by an adult, 18 years of age or older.
15. Anyone riding a horse on SSBC property **MUST** sign a SSBC waiver prior to mounting.
16. **SHOW GROUNDS** are OPEN 5:00pm-7:00pm on Friday and 7:00am on Saturday.
